Join us on Saturday, September 15<sup>th</sup> 2018 for a joint event with the Royal Geographical Society, when we will be seeking the bones of medieval Shrewsbury through its most famous (fictitious) inhabitant, Brother Cadfael. Historical and literary commentary by David Snowden; geographical knowledge supplied by Joya Snowden.

The cost of the event will be £20 a head including transport to and from Shrewsbury and tea after the morning walk round Shrewsbury (2 miles) and afternoon exploration of Shrewsbury Abbey (1½ miles). The walk will begin at the door of Shrewsbury Abbey at 11 a.m. We expect to leave Evesham (Chadbury Farm Shop) at 9 a.m. to allow for heavy Saturday traffic, returning around 6 p.m.
